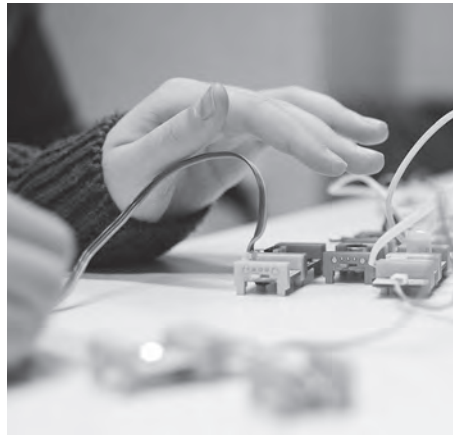

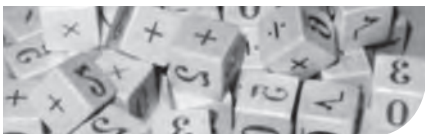

ROCK-ET ON *Grades 4-7*

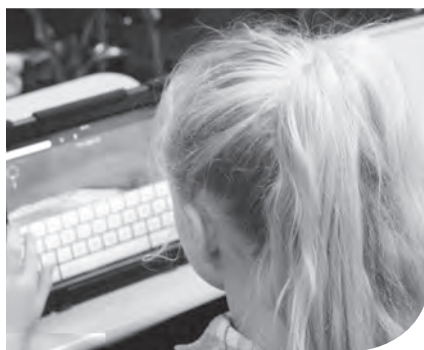
