Introduction to AutoCAD

This introductory course is of particular interest to Architects, Engineers, Landscape and Interior Designers. Topics will include basic drawing commands, editing text, and dimensioning techniques. Other areas addressed are layers, user coordinate system, file management, etc.

AutoCAD II

This course examines all aspects of a small Cape Cod house design from conception to all phases of a working drawing set for construction, including floor plans, elevations, sections and details. The project will cover plotting and printing a finished drawing, file management, dimension variables, polylines, sketching, generation of curves, hatching, and editing text and layers. Participants will also be introduced to blocks and will be taught to create symbols for multiple uses.

Prerequisite: AutoCAD I.
