The Pharmacy Technician Training program will prepare students for entry-level positions in community and hospital pharmacy settings and for the Pharmacy Certified Technician (PCT) Examination. Students will learn about prescription and OTC drugs, compounding, calculations, legal aspects of pharmacy, parenteral administration of drugs, and aseptic techniques, as well as topics in chemistry, anatomy, physiology and pharmacology as it pertains to the pharmacy setting. A strong background in mathematics is recommended.

Entrance Requirements:

- Student must have a high school diploma or equivalent.

Co-requisite: Customer Service for Health Care Professionals.
