The Physical Therapy Aide course prepares students to work in a physical therapy work setting, assisting therapists in improving the patient's function and quality of life. Students will learn about the physical therapy profession as part of the health care team, including rehabilitation terminology, physical therapy settings and specialties, and common medical diagnoses. Students will also learn safe guarding, transport and transfer skills, as well as skills for assisting with therapeutic exercise, gait and balance training, and other physical therapy treatments. Upon successful completion of the course, students will receive a certificate of completion. This course will count toward the admission requirements of the Physical Therapist Assistant two-year degree program at NCC (please contact the Physical Therapy Assistant Program Director for details).
