The Medical Billing & Reimbursement Specialist Certificate Program consists of three courses that will prepare students for an interesting career as a Medical Billing professional. Upon successful completion of required courses, students will be able to understand and facilitate the necessary steps for processing health insurance claims. Student will receive a certificate of completion upon successfully meeting program requirements.

Course Descriptions

Medical Terminology

This course is a comprehensive study of the technical language of medicine through word construction. Students will learn the anatomic and clinical medical terms, anatomy and physiology, pathophysiology, diagnostic testing, and pharmacological agents pertaining to each body system. This course will provide students with a solid foundation to function effectively in health care facility business office.

Medical Insurance & Billing

This course discusses medical insurance and billing as it relates to the effective management of health care offices. It provides entry-level skill practice in scheduling appointments, pre-authorization of surgery, verification of insurance, organization of medical records, billing, bookkeeping and will acquaint students with the major medical insurance programs and issues related to health care today, including HIPAA, electronic medical records, and health care reform. It is designed to offer the practical skill training necessary to become a successful medical office administrative professional.

Medical Coding

This course encompasses most fundamental aspects of the Official Coding and Reporting Guidelines used by providers to facilitate payment of health services. Students will access the internet to research and apply coding concepts and conventions of ICD-10 and CPT-4 coding as they review actual medical records. A hands-on experience is provided with a current medical practice management software application.

Prerequisite: Medical Terminology and Medical Insurance & Billing.
